

**Veterans Who Care Committee-** Two 1,000.00 Scholarships are annually given to a graduating high school senior who is willing to test herself with the rigors of higher education for accredited courses. Special considerations will be given to any descendant of a man or woman who served over 90 days in the Armed Forces of the United States. A copy of the relative's Proof of Honorable Discharge must accompany the application to receive these considerations. Awards will be made to applicants displaying scholastic achievement, potential for success in chosen field, outstanding character and citizenship, school and community service and/or financial need.

The **Journalism scholarship** is intended for graduates who are contemplating a career in journalism or some related field including graphic arts, advertising and photography.
